### **PAWS Act Developments**

It's time for another PAWS Act update! For those who may not already be aware, Paws for Purple Hearts is one of the few organizations selected to participate in the Puppies Assisting Wounded Servicemembers (PAWS) Act of 2021, passed by Congress and signed by the President. Of the five selected sites nationwide, two are from Paws for Purple Hearts, specifically: PPH San Antonio and PPH Alaska.

Since our last update about this pilot program, PPH San Antonio is halfway through Cohort #4 and has started Cohort #5. Our site has shown such great strides with these PAWS Act sessions that we have added an additional Cohort weekly session to help serve more of our Warriors. Through these weekly sessions, we've also had some participants come back as Volunteers and consistent supporters of our organization and mission. Many of our past participants even joined us at our Open House to celebrate our new facility! It has been such a great pleasure working and getting to know each person

that comes through our doors. We are very quickly nearing our first year completed of this pilot program and can't wait to see what else is in store for us!

As a reminder, this pilot program will be ongoing for five years. While we are not receiving funding from the government for providing this program to Veterans, we are incredibly grateful for the continued support and financial contributions that we receive from community members and from donors like you!

### **Major Pupdates!**

Did you know that by the end of 2022, we had welcomed three new puppies to our San Antonio team? Well, say hello to Joy, Moore, and Penn! Joy arrived in San Antonio in September 2022, while Moore and Penn joined in October 2022. These three pups-in-training have helped make such a significant impact on our Warriors through our Canine Assisted Warrior Therapy® sessions.

Little Joy has already been implemented into our CAWT® sessions as well as our PAWS Act cohorts. While Moore and Penn are our youngest team members, they have already been getting their paws wet with session work and are officially participating in PAWS Act sessions with Cohort #5! These pups have big vests to fill, but they are quickly making waves with our Warrior participants.

Not only are these young pups jumping into sessions like champs, but they are also going out and about in the community taking part in our community outreach events and conducting training
