


¡Viva la Fiesta!

PAWS Act Update

It is time for a PAWS Act update! If you recall, Paws for Purple Hearts is one of the few organizations selected to participate in the "Puppies Assisting Wounded Service members" (PAWS) for Veterans Therapy Act of 2021 pilot program, passed by Congress and signed by the President. Of the five selected organizations, two Paws for Purple Hearts sites were selected: PPH San Antonio and PPH Alaska.

Since our last update of this pilot program, PPH San Antonio has officially completed one full year of the PAWS Act pilot program and has completed SIX cohorts! Our site has made such great strides with these PAWS Act sessions that we have added an



additional Cohort session to help serve more of our Warriors. Through these weekly sessions, we've also had some participants come back as Volunteers, Puppy Parents, and consistent supporters of our
